Advanced notifications of shipments into or within South Carolina

Why we receive advanced notifications dealing with category 1, spent nuclear fuel, and other radioactive shipments.



§ 71.97 Advance notification of shipment of irradiated reactor fuel and nuclear waste.

(a)(1) As specified in paragraphs (b), (c), and (d) of this section, each licensee shall provide advance notification to the governor of a State, or the **governor's designee**, of the shipment of licensed material, within or across the boundary of the State, before the transport, or delivery to a carrier, for transport, of licensed material outside the confines of the licensee's plant or other place of use or storage.

§ 73.37 Requirements for physical protection of irradiated reactor fuel in transit.

(iv) Preplan and coordinate shipment information no later than 2 weeks prior to the shipment or prior to the first shipment of a series of shipments with the governor of a State, or the **governor's designee**, of a shipment of spent nuclear fuel through or across the boundary of the State, in order to:

§ 37.77 Advance notification of shipment of category 1 quantities of radioactive material.

(1) The notification must be made to the NRC and to the office of each appropriate governor or governor's designee.

(f) *Protection of information.* State officials, State employees, and other individuals, whether or not licensees of the Commission or an Agreement State, who receive schedule information of the kind specified in § 37.77(b) shall protect that information against unauthorized disclosure as specified in § 37.43(d) of this part.

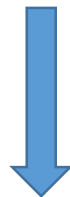
SAFEGUARDS INFORMATION OR OTHER SENSITIVE NOTIFICATIONS



Governor's Designee (one person)



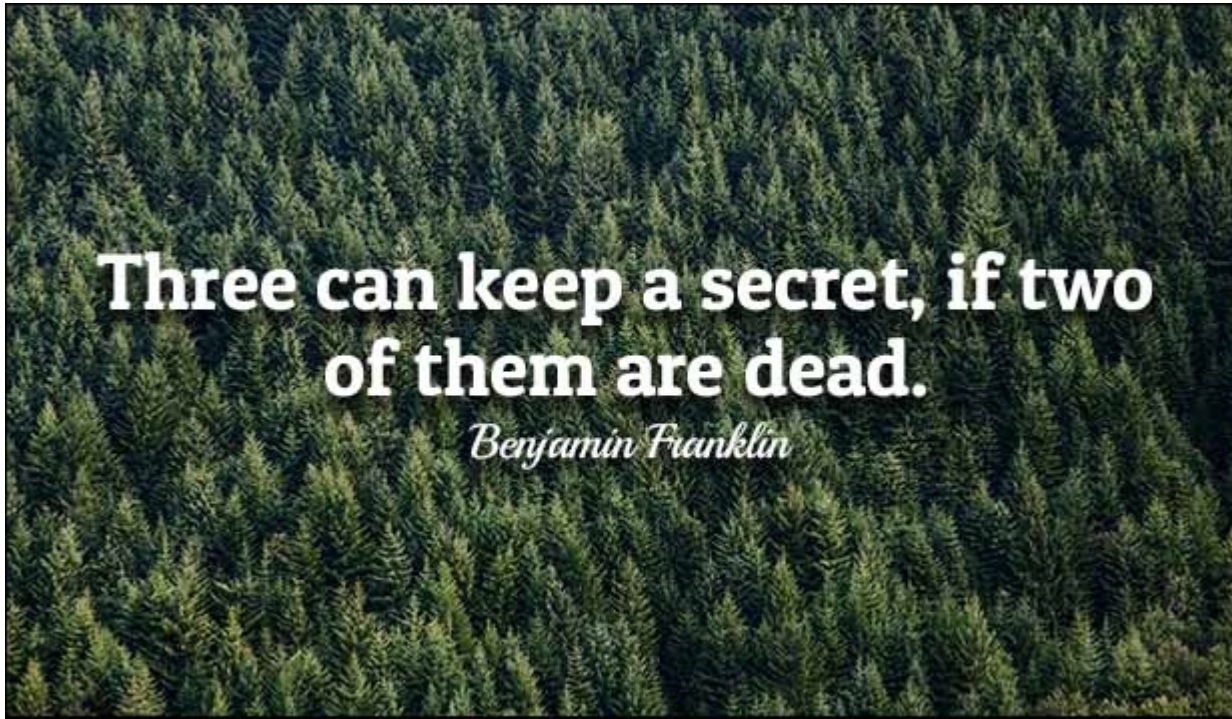
Trained Agreement State Staff (two people)

1ST

LIMIT THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE WHO
HAVE ACCESS TO THE INFORMATION.



2nd

Insure that only authorized personnel have access to this information.

The Governor of a State or his or her designated State employee representative

Federal, State, or local law enforcement personnel

Agreement State employees

Emergency response personnel who are responding to an emergency

If none of the above; have they had fingerprinting, identification, and criminal history record checks?

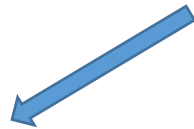
3rd

Who has a “need to know?”

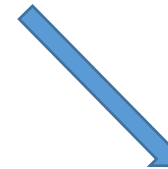
Governor's Designee, Susan Jenkins, immediate supervisor to trained Agreement Staff personnel.



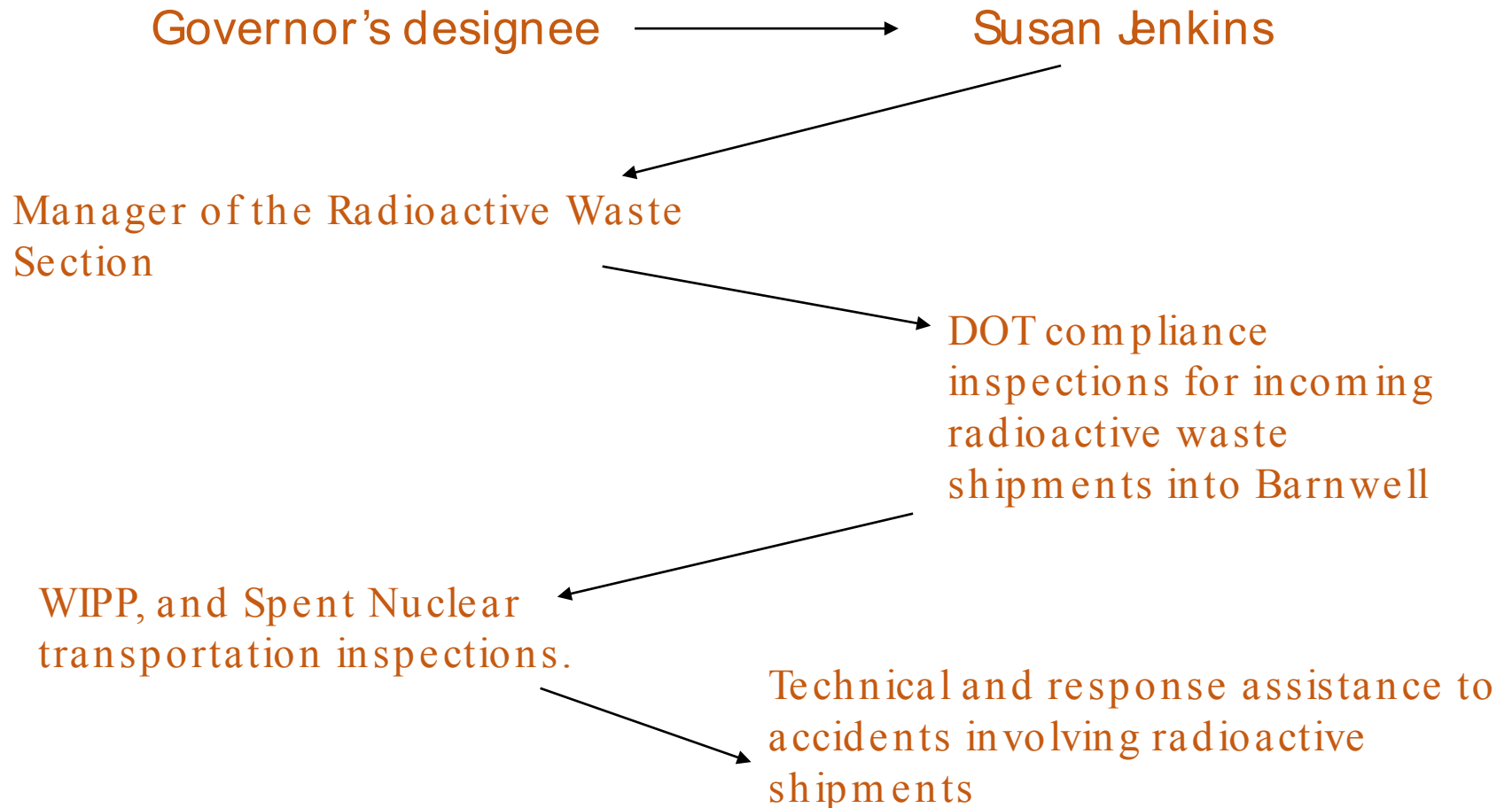
Currently two trained staff members involved in disseminating information and conducting transportation inspections.



SLED, South Carolina Law Enforcement Division, is notified of all the different types of Safeguards Information.



SCTP, South Carolina Transport Police, only receive notifications of HRCQ involving DOE notifications to conduct CVSA Level VI inspections



- 1) Keep information secured.
 - a) Only Authorized Personnel
 - b) Locked Safe
 - c) Secured Fax
 - d) Encrypted/Password Protected Email

- 2) Notify only those who have a need to know.
 - a) State Law Enforcement Division
 - b) State Transport Police

- 3) Destroy information appropriately.
