By memorandum dated July 5, 1990, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) informed the NRC of the results of their observations of the offsite activities during the WNP-2 emergency preparedness remedial drill on April 3, 1990. The memorandum states that the previous deficiency was closed; therefore, FEMA now has reasonable assurance that the public health and safety can be adequately protected in the event of an accident at WNP-2. Copies of the FEMA memorandum and report are enclosed.
