This letter transmits the FEMA report for the April 3, 1990, drill involving Benton and Franklin Counties. The report documents the counties satisfactory demonstration of their capabilities to alert and notify the recreational population in the Horn Rapids Off-Road Vehicle (ORV) Park and surrounding area. FEMA concludes in their cover letter to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission that there is now reasonable assurance that the public health and safety can be adequately protected in the event of an accident at the WNP-2 Nuclear Power Plant. However, FEMA's report also documents numerous areas requiring corrective action. Please keep us informed of the resolution of these corrective actions.
