A management evaluation has been performed to assess the readiness of Crew A to successfully participate in an NRC administered operational evaluation on February 27, 1992.

Crew A has successfully completed the scheduled remediation training program and all crew and individual weaknesses which were identified during the training have been fully addressed.

Based on a thorough review of the remediation program, the Operations Training Review Board recommended that the crew be presented for an operational evaluation. I discussed this matter in depth with members of the review board and the crew, and personally witnessed the crew's performance in recent scenarios. As a result, I concur with the board's recommendation that Crew A is prepared for an operational evaluation on Thursday, February 27, 1992.
