This e-mail is to provide an update on the petition for rulemaking (PRM) that you submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), PRM-20-30, dated February 24, 2015 (Accession No. ML15075A200 in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS)). The NRC received two additional petitions on the same topic (PRM-20-28 and PRM-20-29); all three petitions were docketed using the same Docket ID (NRC-2015-0057). You requested that the NRC amend its requirements in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 20 to take radiation hormesis into account.
