Dear Ms Snyder,

Thank you for your October 16, 2017 note regarding the information sent to you by Ms. Harden.

Yes, it would be very helpful for Ms Harden's submissions to be part of the record of my petition request. I do not plan on submitting any additional information unless requested or needed for clarification or response to a question the Board may have.

Her synopsis will present a succinct historical perspective and provide an independent commentary on the testimony of former PTA commandant, Colonel Killian and other interested persons. Her preparation could be very helpful to the Petition Review Board in understanding that air sampling was at one time the favored monitoring approach and then very silently and swiftly, it was changed to previously-claimed non-existent sediment samples. It also provides information on the existence of more DU than simply from the 714 spotting rounds that were shipped to the U.S. Army Davy Crockett nuclear weapons group stationed in Hawaii, as this was newly recognized from parts now identified as from the main warhead, as shown in the contractor's photographs at PTA. I believe her submission is certainly consistent with the issue that less than full disclosure was provided for NRC's sanction of the ERMP, hence leading to my request for the license to be amended and the reinstatement of air sampling for the primary monitoring mode.

I had asked Ms Harden if she could provide the official testimony of Colonel Killian and she felt she could get the video testimony or perhaps a County transcript. She will send it directly to you to minimize delay.
