Arizona Public Service Company (APS), as Project Manager and Operating Agent for the Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station (PVNGS) Unit 1, 2 and 3, is submitting herewith forty (40) copies of the PVNGS response to the required actions based on the generic implications of the Salem ATWS events.

This submittal responds to the actions stated in the referenced letter, except for Item 2.2.2. APS is participating in the Nuclear Utility Task Action Committee (NUTAC) which is operating under the auspices of INPO's Analysis and Engineering Industry Review Group. The NUTAC's efforts are scheduled to be completed by March 1984. We anticipate submitting the APS response to Item 2.2.2 sixty (60) days after the completion of the NUTAC effort.
