Sherman of your staff on September 14, 1984. Attached please find the Bechtel Technical Specification (13-NM-997B) and the Science Applications International Corporation Proposal for "Airborne Monitor Sampling Line Plateout and other Measurements at Unit 1, PVNGS" which describe our program to meet our Regulatory Guide testing commitment.
