STAFF REQUIREMENTS - DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE VOTE ON FULL POWER OPERATING LICENSE FOR ST. LUCIE-2, 9:00 A.M., FRIDAY, JUNE 10, 1983, COMMISSIONERS' CONFERENCE ROOM, D.C. OFFICE (OPEN TO PUBLIC ATTENDANCE)

The Commission met to discuss with staff the status of their review of the readiness of St. Lucie-2 for a license above 5 percent power, as outlined in their package submitted to the Commission on June 3.

Staff noted they would modify the license amendment regarding post trip procedures and the natural circulation boron mixing test in accordance with the discussion.

The Commission voted 5-0 to allow staff to issue a full power due 6/10/83-issued authorization.

Commissioner Roberts requested that the staff provide information on whether or not the review panel implemented in Region II to inspect licensee documentation is used in the other regions.
