SUBJECT: REANALYSIS OF REACTOR COOLANT PUMP SEIZED ROTOR AND LOSS OF ALL NON-EMERGENCY AC POWER

As a result of several conference calls, you supplied some clarifying information concerning the reactor coolant pump seized rotor and loss of all non-emergency AC power accidents. In reviewing this information, several areas of apparent conflict have been identified. 
