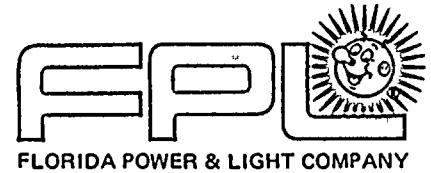

Reactor Coolant System Vents

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.90, Florida Power & Light Company submits herewith three signed originals and forty copies of a request to amend Appendix A of Facility Operating License DPR-67.

This change was requested by the NRC in Generic Letter 83-37 to provide operability requirements for the reactor coolant system vents.

The proposed amendment is described below and shown on the accompanying Technical Specification pages.

Page 3/4 4-61

A specification is added to require reactor coolant system vent paths to be operable. This is the same specification as 3.4.10 for St. Lucie Unit 2.

Page B3/4 4-15

The bases for the reactor coolant system vents is added.

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.91(b)(I), a copy of this proposed license amendment is being forwarded to the State Designee for the State of Florida.

This change was requested by the NRC staff and was previously issued for St. Lucie Unit 2. Therefore, in accordance with 10 CFR 50.91(a)(I), we have determined that this amendment does not involve any significant hazards considerations pursuant to 10 CFR 50.91(c) in that the amendment does not:

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

- 1) involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident previously evaluated; or
- 2) create the possibility of a new or different kind of accident from any accident previously evaluated or
- 3) involve a significant reduction in a margin of safety.

Because this change is made at NRC request, a license fee is not provided with this request.

The proposed amendment has been reviewed by the St. Lucie Facility Review Group and the Florida Power & Light Company Nuclear Review Board.
