Enclosed is an application from AREVA Inc., dated August 24, 2017, requesting amendment No. 01 to its existing export license (XW015). The license presently authorizes the export of up to 2 kilograms (kg) of uranium-235, contained in 40 kg uranium enriched to 5 WGT % maximum, as Class A radioactive waste imported in accordance with NRC license IW009, and subsequent amendments, from Advanced Nuclear Fuels GmbH in Germany.

The purpose of this amendment is to: 1) change the licensee name; 2) change the licensee point of contact; and 3) extend the date of expiration from December 31, 2020 to December 31, 2023.

We intend to issue the requested license after the 30-day time period allotted for public review expire and it is determined applicable export license criteria are met.
