Enclosed is a copy of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Radiological Emergency Preparedness final report for the Waterford 3 Steam Electric Station's Medical Services drill evaluated on September 7, 2017. FEMA Region VI staff evaluated the Ochsner Clinic Foundation and St. Charles Parish Hospital Emergency Medical Services. There were no Findings or Plan Issues identified during the evaluation.

Based on the results of the drill, the planning and preparedness for the State of Louisiana and affected local jurisdictions provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken to protect public health and safety in the event of a radiological release. Therefore, 44 CFR Part 350 approval of the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the State of Louisiana, specific to Waterford 3, will remain in effect.
