Dear Mr. van der Heide:

On March 3, 2017, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued a letter to you describing the final disposition of an investigation completed on October 9, 2015, by the NRC's Office of Investigations (OI), concerning your activities at the Louisiana Energy Services, LLC (LES) enrichment facility. A version of the NRC letter in which your home address was redacted was made publicly available (ADAMS Accession Number ML17065A247) in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, requests for withholding."

On September 22, 2017, you submitted a letter to the NRC stating your views on how the NRC handled your personally identifiable information (PII) in our letter dated March 3, 2017. Your letter stated that the NRC's release of your full name and job title allowed others to access personal information about you, contrary to European rules (ADAMS Accession Number ML17268A286).

Information on significant enforcement actions taken against individuals involved in NRC-regulated activities is made publicly available in accordance with agency policy and 10 CFR 2.390, provided that PII and sensitive information that would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy are not disclosed.

The NRC believes that the March 3 letter was issued in accordance with the agency's policy and the Privacy Act of 1974, which governs the NRC's collection, maintenance, use, and dissemination of information about individuals maintained in a system of records. As stated in your letter dated September 22, 2017, the NRC letter did include your name and job title at the time of the issue that was being investigated. The NRC does not believe disclosure of such information constitutes an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, as it relates to your professional identity.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, a copy of this letter and your response, if any, will be made available for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. If you choose to respond to this letter, to the extent possible, your response should not include any personal privacy, proprietary, safeguards or classified information so that it can be made available to the public without redaction.
