RE: License Amendment Request -- Exemption from 24-Hour Reporting Requirement of 10 CFR 40.60(b)(3) for Medical Treatment of Contaminated Individuals at On-Site Medical Facility, Honeywell Metropolis Works (CAC 000224/04003392/L-2017-LLE-0010)

Mr. Wolf,

By letter date September 7, 2017 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System [ADAMS] Accession Number ML17255A243), Honeywell Inc. (Honeywell or the licensee) submitted an amendment to its Materials License, SUB-526, requesting an exemption, in part, to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 40.60 (b)(3) reporting requirements regarding it Metropolis Works (MTW) facility.

As part of the screening process, the NRC staff has completed the review of the information that Honeywell submitted by letter dated September 7, 2017, and found the information acceptable for detailed review. During this review, the NRC staff will notify you if any additional information, or clarification of existing information, is needed. The staff efforts associated with this review will be charged to Cost Activity Code (CAC) 000224/04003392/L-2017-LLE-0010, "Honeywell – License Amendment Request to Grant Exemption from 24 HR Reporting Requirement." Please reference this CAC in all correspondence related to this action.

Based on our preliminary review and projection of current review schedules, we anticipate completing our review of your request by March 2018. This date could change depending on the findings of our technical/administrative review, urgent assignments, or other factors. We will promptly communicate any significant changes to this schedule.
