Hello John – as we discussed last week, there is one instance in the TP 6&7 biological opinion where there is an incorrect statement regarding the removal of the bridge over the L-31E as part of the restoration of the temporary construction access roads. I highlighted the sentence on page 12 of the attached. While the remainder of the construction access roads will be restored back to their original configuration as discussed in the BO, the bridge is not proposed to be removed.
