Dear Mr. Saporito:

I am acknowledging receipt of your Petition dated January 15, 1994, that you filed pursuant to Section 2.206 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR 2.206). In your Petition, you request that the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (1) initiate escalated enforcement actions against The Atlantic Group (TAG) for violation of 10 CFR 50.7 for TAG's asserted retaliatory conduct as a result of your having engaged in "protected activities" during your employment with TAG from September 29, 1991, to December 31, 1991, at the Arizona Public Service Company, Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station; (2) initiate actions necessary to cause TAG to abate the asserted existing pervasive chilling effect instilled within TAG as result of the Commission's failure to provide you with employee protection afforded under 10 CFR 50.7; and (3) initiate actions to cause TAG to provide a "make-whole" remedy to you for causing your employment termination from Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station and for failing to rehire you. Since this latter remedy is beyond the scope of the Commission's authority, it must be denied.

Since the bases asserted in your January 15, 1994, letter are essentially the same as the bases for your May 12, 1993, Petition, we are treating it as a supplement to your May 12, 1993, Petition. According, the Commission staff will review your Petition as supplemented by your January 15, 1994, letter in accordance with 10 CFR 2.206; and a final decision will be issued within a reasonable time.
