Mr. Belcher,

After further review of the XRF device listed on your license, talking with device manufacturer and the inspection conducted at your storage facility it was determined that you possess a Generally Licensed device that falls under 10 CFR 31.5. Therefore in order to complete the renewal process of your license please:

1. Complete and return the 'Request for Additional Information' sent via email to you on August 21, 2017 and,
2. Have the device manufacturer re-label and re-register the device as a specifically licensed device.

If you would like to keep the device as a Generally Licensed device, you must send the NRC Region I office a letter indicating that you would like to terminate your specific license instead of renewing your license due to your device is a Generally Licensed device.
