Dear Dr. Seibyl:

By letter dated September 26, 2017 (ML17272A796), Molecular NeuroImaging, LLC submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a request for consent to an indirect license transfer of NRC Materials License No. 06-30624-01. Based on the information provided, the NRC understands that the majority of the membership interests of Invicro, LLC (the parent company of Molecular NeuroImaging, LLC) would be sold to Konica Minolta IC, Inc., and the remaining membership interests would continue to be held by Jack Hoppin, Christian Lackas, John Seibyl, M.D., and Kenneth Marek. Following the sale, Invicro, LLC would be an indirect subsidiary of Konica Minolta Precision Medicine, Inc. and Molecular NeuroImaging, LLC would remain a wholly owned subsidiary of Invicro, LLC. We further understand that this transfer would not result in any changes to the licensee name, licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, location of use, or persons responsible for the radiation safety program.

Based on the above and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff Safety Evaluation Report, which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, we consent to the proposed transfer. Please note that you will need to notify us promptly, in writing, after the transaction has been finalized, including a signed copy of the sales agreement confirming completion of the transaction. If this planned sale has not been consummated within 30 days of the date of this letter, please notify us in writing or the NRC's consent may be considered null and void. Future changes in the licensee's name, licensed use, licensed materials, licensed location, or persons responsible for licensed material require submission of a request to amend the license, consistent with NRC regulations.
