It has come to our attention that Amendment No. 76 to your NRC Material License No. 21-04127-06 issued on September 13, 2017, contained an error in Subitem No. 9.M. Subitem No. 9.M. refers to "10 CFR 35.500" but it should refer to "10 CFR 35.600."


