PROGRAM SCOPE

This was an unannounced assist inspection of a nondestructive testing company authorized to use radioactive material for industrial radiography at various field stations and at temporary job sites throughout NRC jurisdiction. The scope of this inspection was limited to a review of the licensee's compliance with NRC security requirements at a field station in Prudhoe Bay, Alaska, and at a temporary job site near Milne Point, approximately 30 miles northwest.

PERFORMANCE OBSERVATIONS

The inspector toured the field office in Prudhoe Bay and the job site at Milne Point to evaluate the licensee's measures for radioactive materials security. The inspector found that the licensee adequately secured all such material from unauthorized access, or else maintained control and constant surveillance of it.

No violations of NRC requirements were identified as a result of this inspection.
