IMPC indicated that the carpeting installed had a higher flame spread rating than permitted by NRC guidelines and requested the staff to review and approve the installation of the carpeting in the control rooms. Enclosed is the staff evaluation.

Based on our evaluation, the staff concludes that the installation of the carpeting in the Unit 1 and Unit 2 control rooms is acceptable.
