SUBJECT: NRC BULLETIN 88-01 (TACS NOS. 67655 and 67656)

By letter dated February 5, 1988, the NRC issued Bulletin 88-01. The purpose of the bulletin was to provide information on Westinghouse series DS circuit breakers and safety concerns associated with their use and to request that addressees using these breakers in Class 1E service perform and document inspection of the welds on the pole shafts and inspection of the alignment in the breaker closing mechanism.

By letter dated April 13, 1988, you provided your response to NRC Bulletin 88-01. Your response indicated that the Westinghouse breakers used at D.C. Cook are type DB-50; Westinghouse DS/OSL type circuit breakers are not used at D.C. Cook.

Based on your April 13, 1988 response to NRC Bulletin 88-01, we consider our review complete. This completes our action under TACS Nos. 67655 and 67656.


