This is to acknowledge receipt of Revision 7 to the Donald C. Cook Emergency Plan dated October 19, 1988. This revision was received in our office on November 2, 1988.


We have reviewed the changes to the Donald C. Cook Emergency Plan and determined that they are consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54(q) and do not decrease the effectiveness of the emergency plan. These changes are, therefore, acceptable.

Please be reminded that 10 CFR 50.54(q) requires NRC approval of any changes to your emergency plans which may decrease their effectiveness.
