In Reference 1, Louisiana Energy Services (LES), dba URENCO USA (UUSA), requested approval of an amendment to Materials License SNM-2010 to revise License Condition 10 and requested approval of revisions to Information System Security Plans.

Reference 2 provided interim approval to implement the changes and required that final copies of Rev 2 of the CMS-MFD ISSP and Rev 3 of the PCTS-ETS ISSPs be provided to NRC and DOE. NRC and DOE representatives inspected these changes the week of November 13th during the annual information security inspection and found the changes to be adequate. UUSA herewith provides these ISSPs.

Enclosures 1 and 2 contain Security-Related Information and disclosure to the public could present a security vulnerability. UUSA requests that these enclosures be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390(d)(1). The Enclosure 3 affidavit supports this withholding request.
