Dear Mr. Fitzpatrick:

In August 1991, NRC published a new rule in 10 CFR Part 50 which affects the manner in which data will be transmitted from licensees to the NRC Operations Center during situations classified as an Alert or a higher emergency classification. The rule requires the implementation of the Emergency Response Data System (ERDS) by power reactor licensees. The implementation program is outlined in Revision 1 to NUREG 1394, which Headquarters recently forwarded to affected licensees.

Among NRC's responsibilities in the ERDS implementation process is providing a "site visit" during which site specific implementation issues can be discussed. These meetings are conducted by the ERDS Project Officer, from the Office for the Analysis and Evaluation of Operational Data, and the ERDS implementation contractor. Licensees have generally been represented at these meetings by emergency planning, computer systems and licensing staff.

In order to more efficiently conduct these site visits, the ERDS Project Officer and the ERDS contractor will be conducting ERDS meetings with six licensees in the Region III office on October 8 and 9, 1991, in Conference Rooms A and B. Each day's agenda and topics are summarized in the enclosures. Based on discussions between Mr. T. Ploski of my staff and Ms. J. Lewis of your staff, we understand that your representatives will be attending the generic ERDS presentation beginning at 8:00 a.m. on October 8 and the site specific meeting beginning at 3:00 p.m. on that date.
