The United States Environmental Protection Agency is requesting the amendment of its NRC license (34-12736-02) for our facilities located in Cincinnati, Ohio. We request the removal of Dr. Shay Fout as an authorized under condition 12 of the license. Dr. Fout has retired from federal service. In conjunction with this request, we request the removal of Sulfur-35 from our license. EPA Cincinnati has not possessed any material containing Sulfur-35 in over 15 years and has no future plans to utilize this isotope.

In addition, EPA Cincinnati is requesting the removal of Cadmium-109 from our license. Cadmium-109 was possessed as a sealed source was disposed through transfer to a specifically licensed and permitted disposal service in August of 2017. EPA Cincinnati has no future plans to utilize this isotope.

All other license conditions would remain the same.
