Dear Mr. Grosso,

This is in reference to your letter dated October 11, 2017, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 08-17447-01, Docket No. 03012771. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. You have requested the addition of a prototype mobile gamma system which is not in the Sealed Source and Device Registry(SS&D). 10 CFR 30.32(g)(1) in part, requires the applicant to provide the information identified in 10 CFR 32.210(c). From your application, it appears that the requested source and device is contained inside a gauge device which is registered, however, the shutter and additional safety mechanisms for the use of this device is being operated by the mobile gamma system. You state that the prototype is very similar to the specifications of the current mobile gamma system which is registered in the SS&D. If the device being used (the prototype mobile gamma system) is very similar to another device currently in the SS&D, you may submit the manufacturer and model number of the device that is registered and describe the specific changes to the prototype device as it is described in the SS&D.
2. Please clarify the other information about the prototype mobile gamma system.
 - a) The use of location was stated differently than currently listed on the license. Please confirm that it will be used at your facilities operated by the Offices of Field Operations and Border Patrol.
 - b) There were two proposed gauging devices that was listed in the request. Please state the Manufacturer and gauge device that you will be using. Please state the manufacturer and source model number that you will be using.
 - c) This item will be placed on the license as a separate authorization. Please state the maximum amount of material you would like to possess and maximum source activity per sealed source.
 - d) No safety information was provided. Please describe the safety features and procedures with the use of this device.
 - e) Confirm that the training that has been given operations are sufficient for the prototype gamma system or state the training that will be provided.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office (Address below) and refer to Mail Control No. 601414. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter. The letter may be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email; or it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269; or it may be sent by regular mail. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application OR amendment request.
