




## FITNESS FOR DUTY INCIDENT SUMMARY (Does Not Include Pre-Access Testing)






(Cumulative Rate & Events)

#### MANAGEMENT ACTIONS:

Meetings and surveillances are conducted with laboratory, collection site, medical review officer(s), employee assistance program staff, and psychological assessment personnel to assure consistent and effective implementation of the fitness for duty (FFD) program.

Th canine program continues to be a constant reminder to plant personnel of our determination to maintain a drug free work environment. Regular surveys of plant property are conducted by the canine unit, in addition to anti-drug presentations at local schools, other community organizations, and participation in the local youth fair. During this reporting period, the canine unit attended 18 schools in the community, presenting its drug awareness message to 1,244 students. The canine unit additionally attended the youth fair, along with local law enforcement agencies, where a combined presentation of drug awareness was communicated to some 800 in attendance. The canine unit additionally responded to local law enforcement requests for assistance in seven drug related incidents to perform searches.

#### APPEALS:

One appeal was received during this reporting period associated with a random test, first time positive for THC. The appeal for this individual was denied based on failure to provide sufficient mitigating circumstances or evidence showing why the tests were incorrect.

#### **EVENTS:**

No events were identified as reportable in accordance with 10 CFR 26.73 during this reporting period.

#### TEMPORARY SUSPENSIONS:

No temporary suspensions, or administrative actions were taken against individuals based on on-site presumptive positive for THC and/or cocaine.
