Enclosed is a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the above referenced facility. This NPDES permit constitutes my determination under Title 40, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 125.35, as amended (30FR27080, July 24, 1976).

In accordance with the Environmental Protection Agency regulations found in 40 CFR 125 (as amended July 24, 1974 39FR27076), this permit will become effective on the date noted, provided that no request for an adjudicatory hearing is filed with the Agency. In the event that such a request is filed, the contested provisions of the permit will be stayed and will not become effective until the administrative review process is complete. All uncontested portions of the permit will be considered operative on the effective date and must be complied with by the facility.

If you wish an adjudicatory hearing, a request must be submitted to the Regional Hearing Clerk within 10 days from receipt of this letter. The request will be timely if mailed by Certified Mail within the ten (10) day period. For the request to be valid, it must conform to the requirements of 40 CFR 125.36(b) as noted above.
