
This refers to the inspection conducted by R. J. Vogt-Lowell of this office on September 2-3, 1979 of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. DPR-31 and DPR-41 for the Turkey Point facilities, and to the discussion of our findings held with H. E. Yaeger at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were disclosed.
