SUBJECT: BOMB THREAT

On May 18, 1980, at 1:51 p.m., a bomb threat was received by the Central Dispatch Point, Metropolitan Dade County (Florida) Public Safety Department. An unidentified male voice stated "There is a bomb at Turkey Point." No further information was furnished. A law enforcement unit was dispatched to the site and relayed the information to plant security personnel at 2:14 p.m. Public Safety Department personnel stated that similar threats had been received throughout the day for various locations within Dade County and they considered the validity of this threat to be extremely low. The licensee increased searches, limited vehicle entry to Florida Power and Light vehicles, and conducted a physical search of the plant site. The search was terminated at 6:05 p.m., May 18, 1980 with negative results.

Media interest is not expected at this time. A news release is not planned by the licensce nor the NRC. The State of Florida has been notified. The IAT was notified.

This Preliminary Notification is issued for information only and no further action by IE is anticipated.
