Florida Power & Light Company has completed the actions required by Items 1 through 6 of the subject Bulletin. Based on the review, we feel that we have sufficient hardware, redundancy, diversity, reliability and control to handle a loss of Decay Heat Removal occurrence.

However, our review and analysis identified a need for enhancing existing plant procedures to fully address all aspects of the Bulletin. Accordingly, Off Normal Operating Procedure ONOP 3208.1 will be revised by June 30, 1980 to incorporate additional safeguards against Decay Heat Removal system degradation.

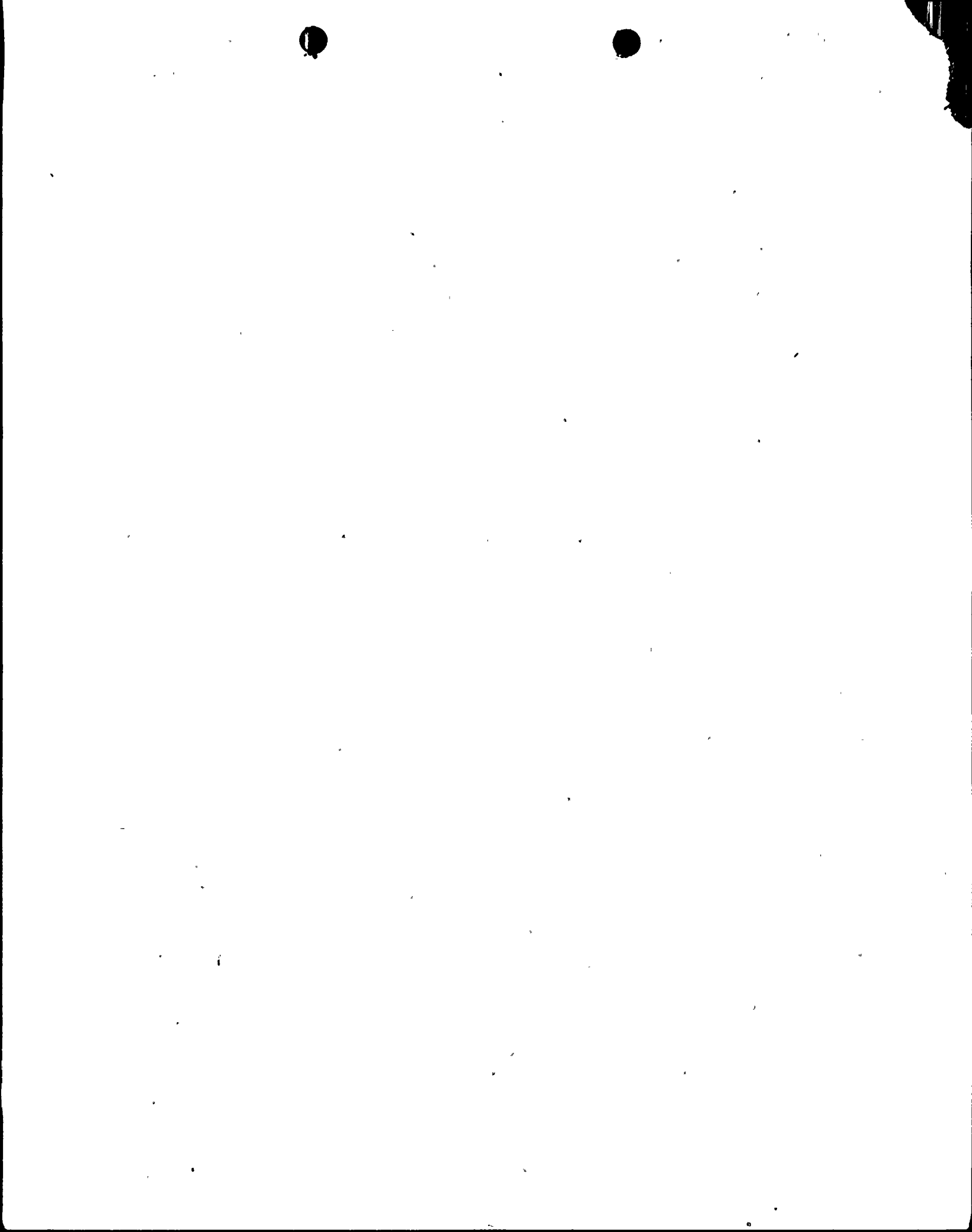
