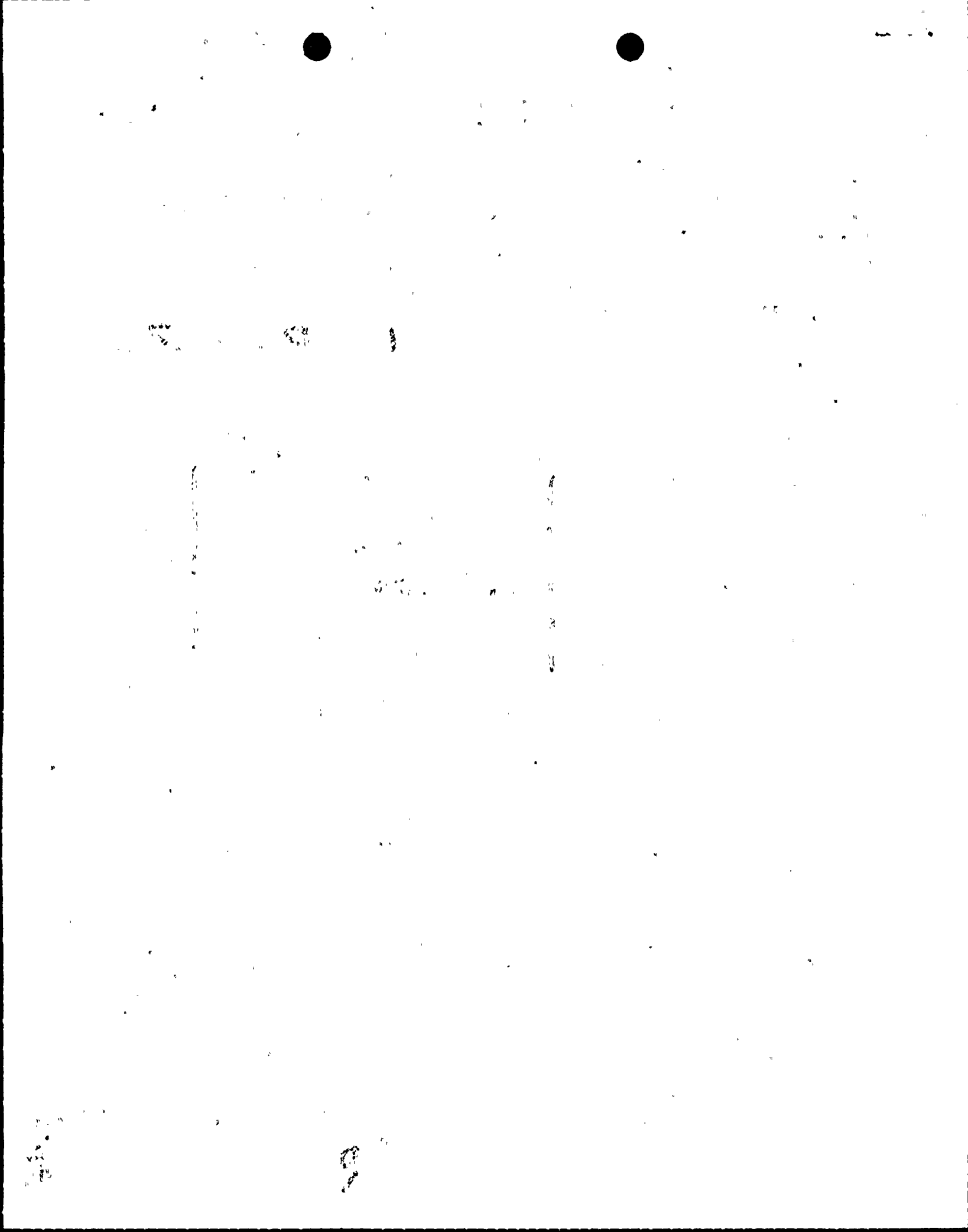

This letter will serve as Mark P. Oncavage's request for a twenty day extention within which to comment on the draft EIS. 
