



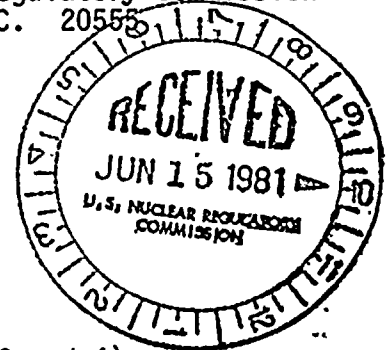

Dear Licensing Board Members:

In its May 28, 1981 Memorandum and Order granting the final Staff motion for summary disposition, the Board directed the parties to address the handling, storage, transportation, or other disposition of low level solid waste generated as a result of the proposed steam generator repairs and to state their positions as to whether the Board should take any action regarding this matter, including the imposition of license amendment conditions. It is the Staff position that the onsite storage of repair-generated low-level solid waste does not pose an undue risk to the health and safety of the public, even in the event of a hurricane or tornado at the site. See accompanying Affidavit of Marshall Grotenhuis on Low-Level Solid Waste Management. It is the further position of the Staff that, while the Board possesses the authority to impose appropriate license amendment conditions, the public health and safety does not necessitate the imposition of any such condition concerning the onsite storage of the low-level solid waste in question. See Grotenhuis affidavit at 5.
