Dear Mr. Jaffer:

The NRC has received your letter of February 12, 1982, seeking the "promulgation of rules giving legal and binding effect to requests for information and authorized communications to appropriate employees of the Commission over WATS and business telephone lines which it supports and operates and public hearings in which the Commission and/or such employees are involved."

I have carefully reviewed your petition and have found that it does not meet the criteria established by NRC regulations concerning petitions filed with the Commission. Specifically, 10 CFR 2.802(c) requires, among other things, that each petition filed:

- (1) Set forth a general solution to the problem or the substance or text of any proposed regulation or amendment; and
- (2) State clearly and concisely the petitioner's grounds for and interest in the action requested.

The request presented in your letter does not clearly describe the problem you want corrected, nor does it provide any proposed text for an amendment. It is not clear to us what you want the NRC to do, or how the NRC can amend its regulations to alleviate what you perceive to be a problem. In addition, your petition does not clearly and concisely state your interest in the action requested. Consequently, I find that your petition is incomplete and does not meet the requirements of 10 CFR 2.802(c).

Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.802(f), you may submit additional data as outlined above to complete your petition within 90 days from the date of this letter. If we do not receive the additional information within that time, your petition will be returned without prejudice to your right to file a new petition.
