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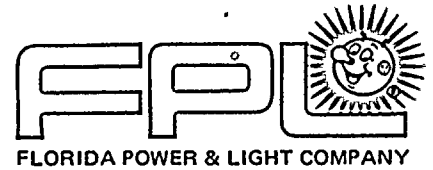

The Steam Generator Repair Program for Turkey Point Unit 4 is governed by the special conditions of DPR-41 in Section 3.H. Several of these conditions require the submittal of procedures or FPL plans for NRC review and approval. We have previously met these conditions for Turkey Point Unit 3 with the following submittals:

Therefore, we do not intend to re-submit these documents for Unit 4. The procedures covered above will be available for your review on site.

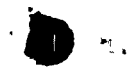
