Standby Feedwater Pump Technical Specification

By letters L-85-372 dated September 30, 1985 and L-85-439 dated December 6, 1985, FPL committed to apply appropriate Technical Specification requirements to address the availability and performance monitoring of the non-safety grade motor driven, standby feedwater pumps. FPL anticipated submittal of the Technical Specification amendment request to the NRC by December 31, 1985.

The proposed Technical Specification amendment has been drafted and reviewed by the Plant Nuclear Safety Committee (PNSC) and the Company Nuclear Review Board (CNRB). However, FPL is currently resolving comments by the CNRB and FPL Engineering Department. As discussed with members of the NRR and I&E Staffs, FPL now anticipates submittal of the proposed Technical Specification by January 31, 1986.
