Subject: NUREG-0737, TMI Action Item II.K.3.5, "Automatic Trip of
Reactor Coolant Pumps" - Turkey Points Units 3 and 4

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By letters dated April 20, 1983, January 30, 1984, October 11, 1985, and
January 7, 1986, you have provided information relating to the above subject.
Your responses addressed the guidance provided in Generic Letter (GL) 83-10
(Items c and d) dated February 8, 1983, and GL 85-12 dated June 28, 1985,
which provided our conclusions regarding the Westinghouse Owners Group
submittals on reactor coolant pump (RCP) trip. GL 85-12 also provided
guidance concerning implementation of RCP trip criteria.

We have completed a preliminary review of the information provided and
included the results of our effort to date as an enclosure to this letter.
We have noted that clarification or additional information is needed in
specific areas of the information you have provided. We anticipate a
considerable portion of the clarification could be obtained by a conference
call with the appropriate members of your staff and will also assure that
any additional information needed will be provided to the NRC staff to allow
us to complete this action for the Turkey Point facility. I will arrange
for the conference call after your staff has received the preliminary review
enclosed.

The reporting and/or recordkeeping requirements of this letter affect fewer
than ten respondents; therefore, OMB clearance is not required under
P. L. 96-511.
