MEETING SUMMARY

This was the fifth NRC/FPL Management Meeting as required by Enforcement Action 87-85. Mr. J. S. Odom, Site Vice President, began the meeting with opening remarks and introduced several security issues which were discussed later in greater detail.

Mr. C. J. Baker, Plant Manager, presented the plant status including significant operations since the last NRC/FPL meeting on March 2, 1988. Both units were operating at full power, with Unit 3 and 4 on-line for 24 and 14 days, respectively.

The Manager-on-shift (MOS) program status was presented by Mr. L. W. Pearce, Operations Superintendent. In addition to the status of the normal MOS program, he discussed how the overall program has matured with the formation of the Plant Supervisor - Nuclear (PSN) - MOS reports which were becoming a viable means of identifying and resolving concerns and recommendations of the PSN. He also mentioned that the plant was reviewing the overall MOS program and evaluating the possibility of phasing out the normal MOS program while making the PSN - MOS program permanent.

Several engineers made presentations on the overall engineering program, both corporate and site, and improvements made to ensure adequate controls are implemented when planning for and conducting plant changes/modifications.

Mr. J. G. West, Acting Security Supervisor, discussed in detail recent responses provided by FPL to the NRC on security related enforcement issues. Also discussed were planned organizational and hardware changes. NRC representatives stated their concerns relative to the timeliness of the planned security organizational changes. The licensee responded that their planned time schedule would be in line with NRC expectations.

In conclusion, several FPL Quality Improvement Programs (QIP) were presented and a status report given on training program improvements. Both the NRC and FPL made positive statements concerning the results of the various improvement projects.
