SUBJECT: DISCRETIONARY ENFORCEMENT TO ENABLE CONTINUED OPERATION WITH COLD
OVERPRESSURE MITIGATION SYSTEM (COMS) NOT FULLY MEETING TECHNICAL
SPECIFICATION BASIS

This letter acknowledges your letter (L-88-420) dated September 16, 1988, requesting discretionary enforcement of Technical Specification (TS) 3.15, Overpressure Mitigation System. This request is limited to the next refueling outage for each unit. A long term resolution to the COMS operability issue will be developed prior to restart from the next scheduled refueling outages.

We have reviewed your request which included discussion with your staff on September 19, 1988, and the request was subsequently granted in a telephone conversation with Region II staff on September 19, 1988.
