Re: Turkey Point Units 3 and 4 Docket Nos. 50-250 and 50-251 Implementation Schedules for 10 CFR 50.48 Fire Protection Modifications

Generic Letter 86-10, "Implementation of Fire Protection Requirements" stated that the NRC would (1) review the dockets of plants covered by 50.48 to determine the schedule deadlines for those plants and (2) inform licensees of those schedule deadlines. The NRC performed a review and as a result of that review by letter dated April 8, 1987, granted FPL an exemption to the schedule provided in 10 GFR 50.48. The exemption stated that, the alternate shutdown panel and common areas would be complete by the end of the Unit 4 Cycle 12 refueling outage, which at that time was scheduled for completion in May 1988.

On March 10, 1987, Unit 4 was shutdown to repair a leaking conoseal connection. That unplanned maintenance outage has rescheduled the Cycle 12 refueling outage. The current outage completion date for Cycle 12 is December 22, 1988.

The Integrated Schedule monthly summary report will provide updated outage schedule changes and will restatus Modification 25-Alternate Shutdown Panel to reflect completion at the end of the current Cycle 12 refueling outage.
