SUBJECT: DRUG ARREST

On June 15, 1989, Florida Power and Light Company (FP&L) representatives informed the NRC Region II that a Turkey Point Plant employee was one of three people arrested in connection with a wide-spread, on-going FBI narcotics investigation. This employee was a fossil plant operator but would have had access to the nuclear plant protected area. His access has been suspended. In addition, a number of people in the geographical area were interviewed by the FBI, including one other FP&L employee and a contract employee. They both requested and have received substance testing. Results are not yet available. Region II is monitoring FP&L's follow-up of the investigation results. There is media interest. Early news reports have erroneously identified the FP&L employee as a "nuclear watch engineer."

The NRC received initial notification of this event by a Region II inspector on June 15, 1989.
