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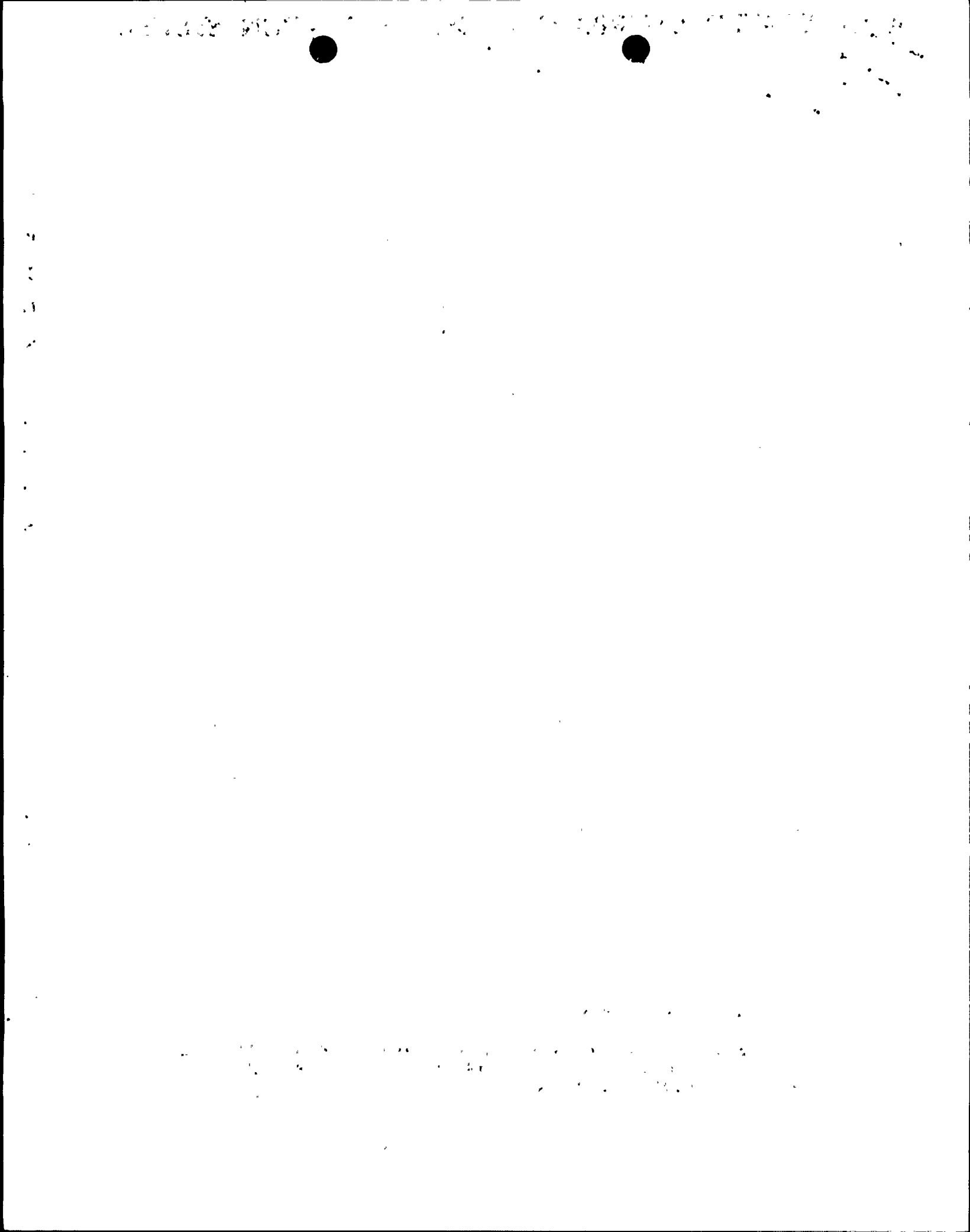

By letter dated March 01, 1991 (L. A. Reyes to J. H. Goldberg), the NRC forwarded to Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) information received from a federal agency other than the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission regarding unsubstantiated Fitness-For-Duty concerns relative to Turkey Point Plant. As stated in the March 01, 1991 letter, the NRC did not attempt to ascertain the accuracy or validity of these concerns due to the source, nature, and sensitivity of the information provided. The NRC additionally stated that no response to its March 01, 1991 letter was required.

An investigation into these unsubstantiated Fitness-For-Duty concerns was conducted by FPL's Nuclear Security Department through our Nuclear Safety SPEAKOUT program. The results of the investigation are attached.

As stated in your March 01, 1991 letter, the attachment contains information exempt from disclosure. Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(a)(6) and (7), we request that this letter be withheld from public disclosure.
