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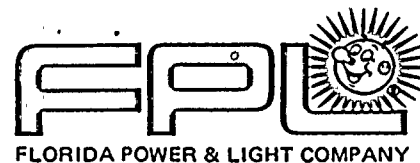
The following information was obtained from the records of the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management, regarding the acquisition of the land described in the preceding page:
