Gentlemen:

We have received copies of the following applications which your Company filed with the Division of Licensing (DL) for review of Technical Specification (TS) changes for Turkey Point Unit Nos. 3 and 4. Fees pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22 were not remitted with these applications.

1. May 5, 1983 request for deletion of terrestrial and other monitoring programs from the TS, and
2. June 3, 1983 request for Optimized Fuel Assembly and Wet Annular Burnable Absorber.

The DL staff has completed preliminary fee reviews for the above applications. Based on information provided as a result of these reviews, it has been determined that each application will involve consideration of a single safety issue. Therefore, two Class III and two Class I fees are appropriate for them. It is requested that your Company remit a sum of \$8,800 to our office. If the DL staff's final reviews reveal that these fees are not correct, you will be notified and any necessary adjustments will be made.
