In my previous letter to you dated November 28, 1983, I informed you that additional documents were being reviewed. The review has now been completed.

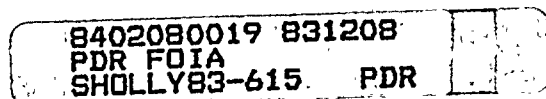
