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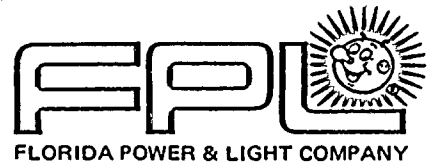

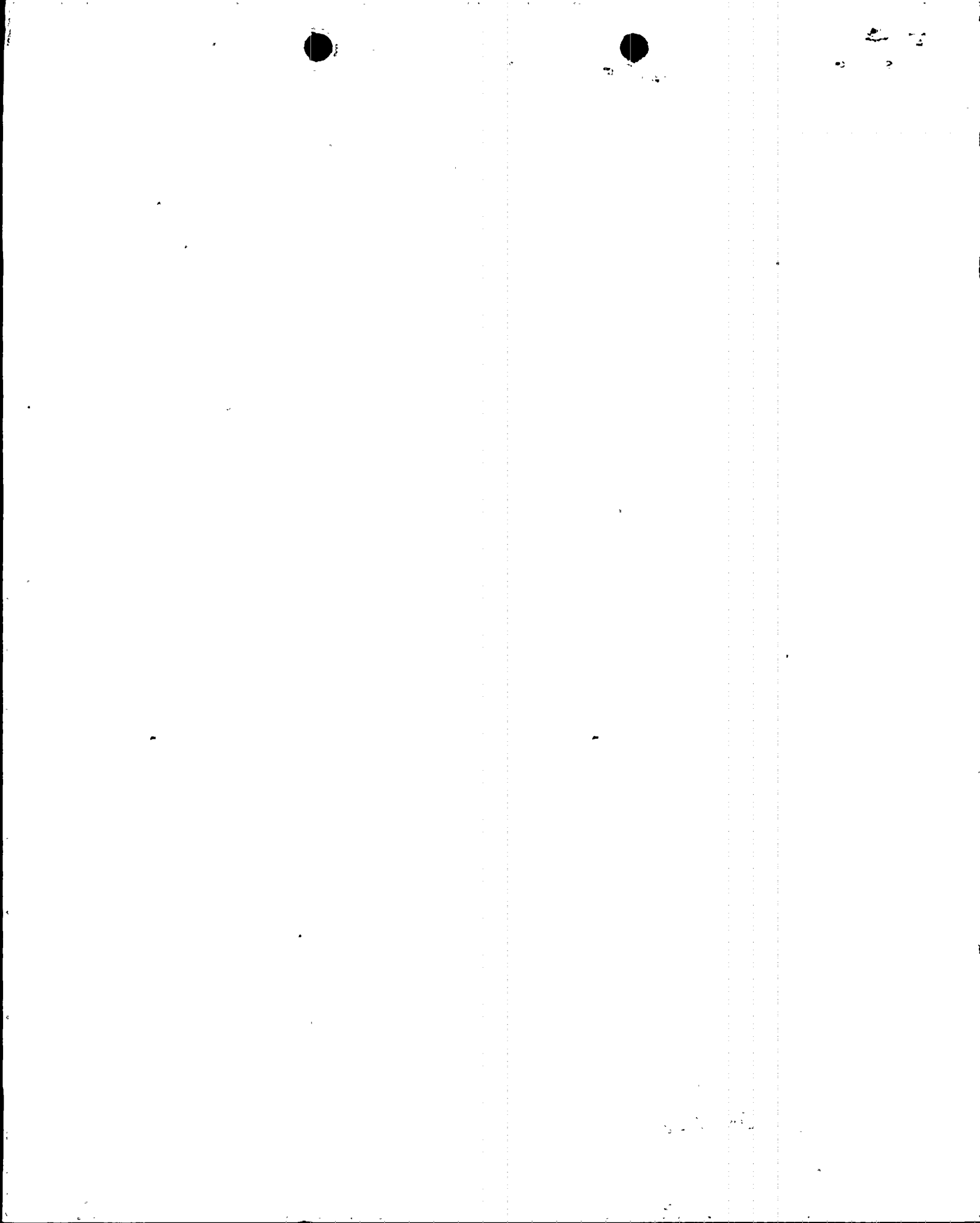
Our letter L-83-555, dated November 8, 1983, provided our response to Generic Letter 83-28 (Required Actions Based on Generic Implication of Salem ATWS Event). Item 4.2 of the Generic Letter required a modification of the reactor trip system to provide an automatic trip feature. Our plan at the time of our response was to provide our design description and implementation plan by May 15, 1984.

Our design is being based on the Westinghouse Owners Group generic shunt trip feature design. Our architect engineer has provided preliminary responses to the thirteen plant specific concerns provided with the NRC safety evaluation of the generic design. The resolution of our comments on the AE's response has, however, been delayed by our recent and continuing evaluation of auxiliary power modifications.

We have, therefore, been required to delay our shunt trip feature submittal until July 15, 1984. Because the shunt trip modification will require an outage for implementation, it is our opinion that this relatively short delay on the design submittal should not affect the final implementation date.


