MAINTENANCE PROGRAM FOR REACTOR TRIP BREAKERS/MAINTENANCE  
AND TRENDING

By letters dated November 8, 1983 and January 18, 1985 you provided your responses to GL 83-28, Supplement 1 to NUREG-0737, in relation to Items 4.2.1 and 4.2.2. These Items required descriptions of your preventative maintenance and surveillance program for reactor trip breakers (RTB) including the trending analysis. We have reviewed your submittals with the assistance of our contractor, Idaho National Engineering Laboratory.

The enclosed Safety Evaluation (SE) provides the details of our review. We have concluded, based on our evaluation, that that your preventative maintenance program for RTBs is acceptable. In addition, your organization for performing trending analysis, which will be used to affect periodic maintenance, is in accordance with the guidance provided in GL 83-28 Items 4.2.1 and 4.2.2 and is also acceptable. The issuance of the enclosed SE completes the above referenced TAC numbers.
