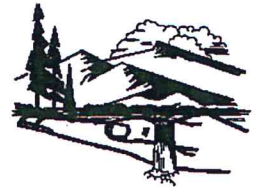

The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality – Land Quality Division (WDEQ/LQD) District 2 Office received Lost Creek ISR's (LCI) Non-Significant Revision (NSR) to Permit 788 to update the Reclamation Bond Estimate table in the Permit's Reclamation Plan. The primary purpose of the NSR was to replace the Reclamation Bond estimate table with the updated and approved 2016-17 bond estimate. The NSR also revised Reclamation Plan page RP-7 to include a reference for ion-exchange and elution circuits in the restoration process. All proposed changes are acceptable.

This Non-Significant Revision known as TFN 6 3/275 is being approved as Change No. 16 to Permit 788.
